

Tuition Fees for the Academic Year 2025/2026 (Until the conclusion of the Summer Term 2026)

The private nursery fees at Impact Montessori Nursery cover all expenses associated with the regular education of your child(ren), unless stated otherwise. The Nursery offers morning and afternoon snacks. Parents are responsible for providing a packed lunch and a healthy drink for their children. Nappies are not included in the nursery fees, and parents must supply appropriate nappies for their child.

Our standard fees typically increase by 5% to 10% at the beginning of the Autumn Term each academic year. Fees are invoiced 4-5 weeks in advance of each new term, and a full term's notice from Impact Montessori Nursery is required for any withdrawals or changes in attendance days.

FOR WORKING PARENTS OR THOSE ELIGIBLE FOR NURSERY EDUCATION FUNDING (NEF) GRANT

Impact Montessori Nursery offers a limited number of funded places for two-year-olds whose parents qualify for the 30-hour Working Parents or Benefits Grant. Parents can

To cover these additional costs, which are typically included in our private nursery fees, a sundries fee is applied per funded hour. This fee is not applicable to fully funded places. Sundries payment - When parents utilise funded hours the NEF Government funding received only covers the basic provision of childcare at your nursery. It does not include the cost of snacks, consumables or extra activities. To cover these additional costs, which are typically included in our private nursery fees, we apply the sundries fee per funded hour. This is not applicable to fully funded places. Please note that funded hours are only applicable during term time, not during school holidays. In the academic year 2025-2026 the current sundries rate for the Nursery under 2s is £0.00. We reserve the right to alter this sum during the academic year and you will be notified of any change.

Children AGED 3 AND ABOVE

FOR NURSERY EDUCATION FUNDING (NEF) GOVERNMENT GRANT

Impact Montessori Nursery offers a limited number of funded places for children aged three and above under both the Universal 15-hour Grant Scheme and the Extended 30-hour NEF grant scheme. Parents can select the days they wish to attend to utilize their funded hours. The Government funding for funded hours covers the essential childcare provision only and does not include snacks, consumables, or additional activities. To account for these supplementary costs, typically covered in our private nursery fees, a sundries fee is applied per funded hour. This fee does not apply to fully funded places. Please be aware that funded hours are valid during term time exclusively and not during school holidays. The fees are outlined below:

Sundries charge- When parents utilize funded hours through the NEF Government funding at our nursery, the coverage is limited to the basic childcare provision. It does not include expenses for snacks, consumables, or additional activities, which are typically part of our private nursery fees. To address these additional costs, we apply a Sundries fee per funded hour. This fee does not apply to fully funded places. Please be aware that funded hours are applicable only during term time, not during school holidays. For the academic year 2025-2026, the current sundries rate for children over 3 years old is £1.50 per hour, and this will be detailed on your invoice starting from January 2026. We retain the right to adjust this amount during the academic year, and any changes will be communicated to you.
